

Dear MS teachers,


Each individual teacher gets only one access code. When you get your access code, **follow these steps** to sign activate the book:

1) go to <https://www.oxfordlearnersbookshelf.com/> >

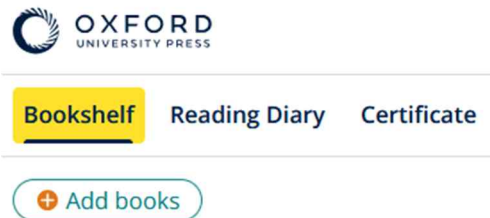

2) Then, Register or Sign in (top-right of page) >

3A) To SIGN IN, type in a gmail account and then click 'Continue with Google' >  ; then, click on your gmail address (the one you typed), and the site will take you to the Bookshelf:

3B) To REGISTER, simply register (create username and password). The site will take you to the Bookshelf:



4) Next, in Bookshelf, lick on the Add books button. (see above)

5) Input your **access code for the book you are teaching**; access codes are at page bottom. The book will load to the Bookshelf.

6) Click on your book! The file will open. It loads pages slowly sometimes, so be patient. All audio files will work within the book (There is no option to download a pdf or mp3s, so you must log in to gain access).

7) Log out at top-right.

NOTE: You must be logged into the OUP site for the book to open and for audio files to play. Log in before class! Feel free to click around in your book prior to the start of camp; get familiar with the resources. 😊
